Online Activities

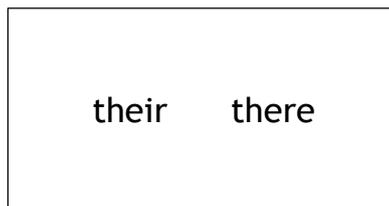
