Look carefully at this picture. What do you think it shows? Talk to your partner and be ready to share your ideas.



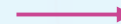
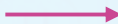

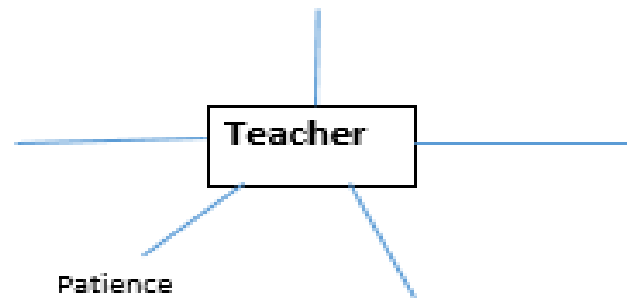
